		On Monday 23 September during tutor time, all staff and students will be taken through what to do if they hear the 'safer inside' alarm that means that everyone must get inside to stay safe.  Students will complete the drill with their tutors so they feel safe and supported and are confident they know what to do in the unlikely event that the alarm sounds.  As a result of this important drill, reception and the Student Support Office will be closed to visitors and students from 08:35 - 08:45 and the main gates will be closed. School	Whole School	Off The Record - Shameless Off The Record (OTR) is a mental health social movement by and for young people aged 11-25 living in Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. Finance	Whole School	Parentpay One-Click Payments (Bank Transfer) Parentpay is encouraging parents to use this payment method rather than card payment. As a school we do not like this as potentially a transaction can fail several days later causing lunch accounts to go overdrawn. Where failed payments are for any item other than dinners the school incurs the charge for two Parentpay transactions. The direct debits take 3 working days to set up before a payment should be attempted. The transaction can then take another 4 days to show on your bank statement. We would recommend continuing with card payment as these transactions are pre-authorised. This can be done by skipping the first page asking you to set up a One Click payment then selecting the 'Add To Basket' button and then 'Other Payment Method' button.
